Assignment Book Policy

The assignment book is an important means of communication between parents and teachers. The fifth grade teachers will use this book to send home notes about the student's work and conduct. Your child is expected to fill out his/her assignment book each day. Parents may check the assignment book daily to see current assignments. Parents are asked to sign the assignment book each night to affirm that they have checked to see that the child's homework is complete. Students are expected to return the assignment book each morning with his/her homework.

Homework Policy

The purpose of homework is to reinforce and practice concepts taught in class. Students will have homework in math almost every night. They will also be expected to read each night. Homework in the other areas of curriculum will be given at various times, but the total homework assigned should not take more than 45 minutes to complete.

Students are responsible for turning in their homework during homeroom (before 7:45 a.m.) each day. Missing or late homework will result in loss of recess privileges until the assignment is complete. You will be notified with a note in the assignment book if your child is consistently missing homework or fails to turn it in on time.

We take a positive approach to homework by offering a reward for students who consistently complete their homework on time.
