May 6: Mother Daughter Book Club

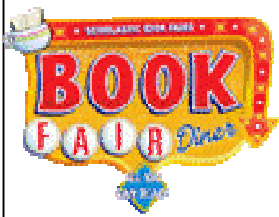
May 10-14: Book Fair week
